On 1 September 2007, the Indiana Society Color Guard conducted a grave re-dedication for William Jerrels in Randolph County. Cook Chapter Vice-President Stuart Hart is a descendant of Jerrals, who was wounded while serving as a private in the Maryland troops. William Jerrels died in 1851 when supplies fell from the wagon he was loading. At the time he was 105 years old and considered "strong and sprightly."
